Patient Access Survey results

In February , we conducted a short patient survey during which we asked 8390 patients (more than half of our patient population) questions on our telephone system and online triage facility. We received 1248 responses which represents 15% response rate and the results are as follow:

1. Call back facility

87% of responders told us they would use a call back facility if this was an option; with 13% stating they would not use it.

2. Longer call queue

59% of participants would like longer call queue whilst **41%** would be happy for the queue to remain at 10 positions/ callers in the queue.

3. Online triage –as alternative option to contact the surgery.

54% of those who responded confirmed they are aware of our online triage facility; whilst 46% were not aware of this option.

Surgery Closures

Outcomes

Thank you to those who participated and submitted their responses; your views are really important to us. As an outcome of this survey we will be implementing a call back facility and we are hoping to be ready to offer this service to our patients by June. With this service in place, we will also be extending our call queue to allow more patients an opportunity to speak to our reception team.

Finally, we will continue to monitor our online triage facility (available via our web: www.oldstationsurgery.co.uk) with view to extending its opening hours.

Blood pressure checks, Coughs, colds and the flu, aches, pains & minor injuries, oral contraception*

Skin rashes and allergies, Urinary tract infections (UTI), *Ear and eye care, Stomach aches such as constipation, diarrhoea, haemorrhoids, or threadworm; Help with medication and repeat prescriptions; Advice on healthy living – how to eat better, lose weight, exercise and stop smoking

*All community pharmacists can provide advice and support, only some can offer prescribed treatment
